01 iMpack is an independent technology company.

iMpack builds human-centered software and intelligent systems. ORION is its flagship product and the focus of current engineering work.

- Parent company: iMpack. Flagship product: ORION.
- Stage: product development with early-access requests open.
- A free website workspace is public; desktop-wide capabilities are still in development.
- No funding, revenue, customer, partnership, or award claims are made.

02 Assistance today sits beside the work instead of inside it.

Most assistants require a person to restate context that is already on screen, then act in ways that cannot be inspected or stopped mid-flight.

- Context is re-entered by hand: copy, paste, re-explain.
- Actions are opaque, so trust caps at drafting text.
- Provider lock-in decides capability, latency, privacy, and cost.

03 Contextual, inspectable, and interruptible by design.

ORION is being built around three commitments that shape the architecture rather than the marketing.

- Start from the task and context a person explicitly permits.
- Make planning, permissions, tool choice, and history readable.
- Route each step to a model by capability, latency, privacy, and cost.

What is being built right now.

Each area below is engineering in progress or specified design, not a shipped feature. Nothing here describes a generally available capability.

- Visual context: a permission-bound layer reading the active window and selection. In development.
- Visible planning: a step-by-step plan naming required tools and permissions. In development.
- Controlled action: explicit permissions, interruptibility, readable records. In development.
- Model routing: provider-agnostic routing foundation. In development.

Sequenced by state, not promised by date.

Published order and status instead of quarters. Items move to shipped only when someone outside the team can use them.

- Now: visual context engine, permission-aware action layer, multi-provider routing, activity record.
- Next: private early-access build, keyboard and voice parity, granular privacy controls, public documentation.
- Later: on-device routing research, personal workflow memory, developer extension interface, paid plans and accounts.
- Labs work is exploratory and may be dropped; removals are published with the reason.

Pricing is published before it is charged.

The public ORION website workspace is free and there is no active checkout or subscription. Future tiers describe direction only.

- Public workspace: free website navigation, theme, language, search, link copying, history, and planning.
- Professional hosted routing: planned; no price or billing is active.
- Team collaboration and audit: planned; no price or billing is active.
- Enterprise: planned custom annual agreement for residency and review needs.
